

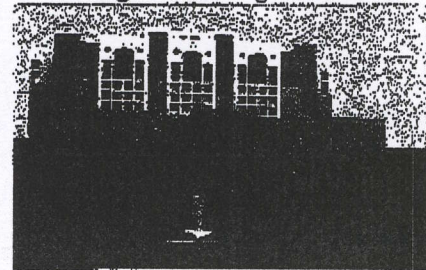

Successful candidate must have a record of creative work, professional writing or research in refereed and other professional journals, and be a recognized authority in the Nursing profession. An earned doctorate in nursing or a related field from an accredited institution and a master's degree in nursing is required. The ideal candidate will have a minimum of three years of academic administrative experience in mentoring and developing research programs, a history of successful externally funded research, and a strong record of outstanding scholarship and publication. Three to five years of appropriate teaching experience, primarily in a post masters/graduate program is preferred. Candidate must have or be eligible for nursing licensure in the state of Florida.
