- Speaker very knowledgeable of subject matter. Topic very interesting

- Minimize sentences on each slide. Summarize into pointers and limit to six lines maximum with only essential information. Too many words on slides
- More slides. Less information on the slides
- “Indigenous” was misspelled as “indiginist” in your PowerPoint. Edit slides for content so all slides are in 3rd person active voice. Too much writing on slides. Example, Experimental Group – received what; Control Group – received what. Synthesize your slides. Use bullets to highlight research. Decrease wordiness.
- Example, Henesy & John (1996) - Caregiver
- Caregiving....
- Type of Design...
- Findings...
- Conclude in your conclusion – one or two slides only
- Summarize – don’t add new studies or new information
- What literature found
- Saps
- What your study did
- Implications for future research
- Usefulness in nursing
