Submissions should address **one or more** of the following conference objectives:

1. Address current issues in health policy and practice.
2. Explore opportunities for men in expanded career options.
3. Articulate gender-based perspectives in a manner that respects inclusiveness.
4. Recognize and celebrate men’s evolution and achievement in nursing profession.
5. Expand networks and relationships with trailblazing nurse leaders.

**Required Formats**

**Research Abstracts**

1. Title
2. Problem or Research Question
3. Theoretical Framework
4. Methods/Design
5. Findings

**Non-Research Abstracts**

1. Title
2. Contribution to the Literature
3. Key Concepts
4. Synopsis
5. Conclusion

Abstracts should be 250-500 words submitted on a one-page, single-spaced typed, 8.5” x 11” page with a one-inch margin on all sides. The abstract must include at least one related objective (see above). Submissions must also include a cover sheet with the abstract title, name(s) of author(s), address, and contact telephone number and e-mail address.

Bibliographies or articles should NOT be included with the submission. Please indicate your preference for

an oral or poster presentation, panel/roundtable or symposia at the top of the response.

All abstracts are subject to a blind review process. Candidates will be notified by email on the status of the abstract (accepted or declined). Each accepted presenter will be required to complete continuing education credit paperwork. Presenters are responsible for registering and paying conference fees.
