Preference will be given to candidates with a minimum of a doctoral degree in nursing or a health-related field of study; evidence of current scholarship related to research, teaching and clinical or administrative experience; and experience with curriculum design and evaluation; program development; student recruitment and advisement; college service and regional, state, national or global collaboration in healthcare. Candidates from underrepresented groups are especially encouraged to apply. Salary is competitive and commensurate with experience.
